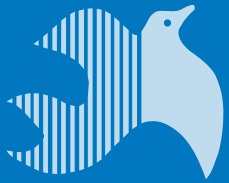

BELIEVING in the power of individuals to change;

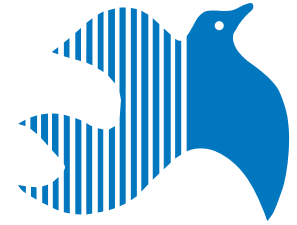
BUILDING LIVES through service programs shaped by the needs and experiences of our participants; and

OUR APPROACH

Founded in 1967, The Fortune Society's vision is to foster a world where those who are incarcerated or formerly incarcerated will thrive as positive, contributing members of society. We do this through a holistic, one-stop model of service provision.

Every year, we serve over 8,000 people at an expanding number of New York City locations. Fortune's program models are internationally and nationally recognized for their quality and innovation; and our continuum of care is informed and implemented by professionals including those with cultural backgrounds and life experiences similar to the participants we help.

JoAnne has more than 45 years' experience in criminal justice, with the last 34 of those years at the helm of The Fortune Society. Under JoAnne's stewardship, The Fortune Society has been recognized as a national leader in providing direct services and advocacy on behalf of justice involved individuals. JoAnne is especially proud of the housing programs she developed including the Fortune Academy in 2002, a nationally recognized emergency and transitional residence housing homeless and formerly incarcerated individuals, and Castle Gardens in 2010, a mixed affordable and supportive permanent housing development. JoAnne has persistently championed the needs of marginalized individuals and implemented innovative housing solutions for the formerly incarcerated.

DAVID ROTHENBERG • *Founder*



In 1967, David produced an off-Broadway play, *Fortune and Men's Eyes*, which changed his life forever. Deeply affected by the plight of the formerly incarcerated, David founded The Fortune Society to help people with justice involvement successfully reenter their communities after incarceration. During his tenure as Executive Director, David led the organization through a period of tremendous growth and advocacy – from the creation of life-changing programs like Education and Employment Services to being one of the few outside observers at the Attica uprising and winning an important legal victory enabling *Fortune News* to be distributed in prisons. Since “retiring” in 1986, David continues to volunteer at Fortune and mentor clients.
