Position Summary: 1-3 volunteers will work together with staff each Wed to set up and breakdown a food demonstration as well as fill bags of food that are then distributed to about 80-300 Castle residents and neighboring community members. Spanish-speaking strongly preferred.

Tasks:

- Set up and breakdown food demonstration station.
- Distribute bags of food (must be able to lift a min of 20lbs).
- Help maintain orderly line up

Requirements

- Must be 18+ of age.
- Must show proof of completed COVID-19 vaccination (boosters not required to comply with EO47).
- Must be able to lift a min of 20lbs.
- Able to dress for inclement weather (distribution location is outside)
- Ability to arrive promptly and communicate if running late
