Position Summary: The Employment Services Department: CRED Workshop Intern will support the department with various administrative and operational duties to ensure programs/services are running efficiently.

Tasks / Primary Responsibilities:

- Follow up with participants referred to Employment Services and collect/distribution information. Help with daily administrative tasks.
- Identifying relevant job openings, presenting qualified candidates.
- Assisting clients in crafting compelling resumes and practicing interview skills.
- Providing guidance on career pathways, job market trends, and decision-making.
- Offering on-the-job support to participants to ensure successful transition and retention. Building relationships with employers to understand their hiring needs and advocate for clients.

Learning Objectives:

- Learn Workforce Development Roles in the nonprofit sector.
- Learning the skill of building relationships with Employer partners
- Gaining a rapport with participants while increasing knowledge of working with the formerly incarcerated population.
- Acquire database management skills in a professional setting.

- Knowledge of Microsoft Word and Excel. Ability to take minimal direction and multitask. Previous experience with customer service.
